The coach will work closely and collaboratively with the Director of Athletics and the Assistant Director of Athletics, while reporting directly to the Director of Athletics.

Duties and Responsibilities:

Program:

- To be responsible for ensuring the health and safety of all student athletes in the program
- To model sportsmanship and ethical behavior for student athletes
- To understand the rules of the sport and conform to conference and school policies
- To plan practices to make the maximum use of practice time
- To demonstrate an understanding of fitness, conditioning, and the development of skills sets
- To demonstrate an understanding of game planning, strategy, and substitutions of players according to situations
- To use a variety of proven coaching techniques to motivate student athletes

Personnel:

- To consult with the Director of Athletics regarding the assignment of faculty to assistant and sub-varsity coaching positions
- To assist in the training of all assistant and sub-varsity coaches
- To ensure that all assistant and sub-varsity coaches are performing their duties at the very highest level of professionalism.
- To demonstrate a high level of collegiality by planning collaboratively, observing, and providing feedback to assistant and sub-varsity coaches
- To seek continuous professional growth for self, assistants, and sub-varsity coaches

Administrative:

- To work in collaboration with the Admissions Office to develop and conduct a plan for attracting and enrolling student athletes for the program

- To organize and submit information on the program to:
 - the Communications Office for public recognition of athletic achievements
 - the Alumni and Development Office for historical purposes
 - the website for public access to schedules, scores, directions, and announcements
- To report attendance to the Assistant Athletic Director on a daily basis
- To work in collaboration with the College Advising Office to actively assist student-athletes with the college recruitment and selection process
- To represent the school at various league, state, regional, and national athletic associations as assigned by the Director of Athletics
- To assist in the management of equipment, locker rooms, and fields.
- To perform other duties as assigned by the Head of School.
- To support the leadership of the school by upholding its mission, values, and policies.
