The position includes teaching four or five sections under the supervision of the Humanities Division Head.

Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate:

- A genuine love for the written and spoken word and a persistent desire to open students' hearts and minds to the literary world;
- Outstanding skills in oral and written communication;
- An abiding belief that all students can grow and succeed in a rigorous curriculum fostering critical thinking, creative engagement and communication skills;
- Experience with Design-Thinking and Problem-Based Learning;
- Expertise in the integration of technology into classroom instruction;
- Ability to work well in a student-centered curriculum;
- Understanding of learning styles and differentiated instruction;
- An eagerness to work in an intense, changing and supportive learning community.

Applicants must be able to attend a week-long 1st Year Faculty Workshop in mid- August.

Other duties for this position include: advising, participation as an athletic coach or activities leader for two seasons each year and active participation in our residential program including weeknight-weekend supervision.
