Helpful Information

Travel Days and Residence Hall Closures: students are permitted to depart campus following their last commitment prior to campus breaks. Residence halls officially close at 12:00 pm on "Travel Days." Residence halls will reopen at 4:00 pm following breaks and students should not return to campus until this time.

Residence Halls are considered "closed" during the following breaks and students will be expected to depart campus during these times:

• Thanksgiving Break

- Winter Break
- February Break*
- Spring Break

*International students and long-distance boarders may pre-arrange to remain on campus during February Break

Community Weekends: all boarding students are required to remain on campus for Community Weekends; exceptions will be made for formal commitments that do not conflict with required campus events. Certain events on these weekends may be required for both boarding and day students.

Formal/Community Dinners are required for all boarding students. Day students are welcome to attend but must notify the Student Life Office in advance for seating arrangements.

Advisory Home Nights are required for all boarding and day students. Advisors host meals and activities for their respective advisory groups either on or off campus.
