Helpful Information

Travel Days and Residence Hall Closures: students are permitted to depart campus following their last commitment prior to campus breaks. Residence halls officially close at 12:00 pm on "Travel Days." Residence halls will reopen at 4:00 pm following breaks and students should not return to campus until this time.

Residence Halls are considered "closed" during the following breaks and students will be expected to depart campus during these times:

- Thanksgiving Break
- Winter Break
- February Break*
- Spring Break

*International students and long-distance boarders may pre-arrange to remain on campus during February Break

Community Weekends: all students are required to remain on campus for Community Weekends.

Formal/Community Dinners are required for all students.

Advisory Home Nights are required for all boarding and day students. Advisors host meals and activities for their respective advisory groups either on or off campus. These dates will be announced at the beginning of the school year.
