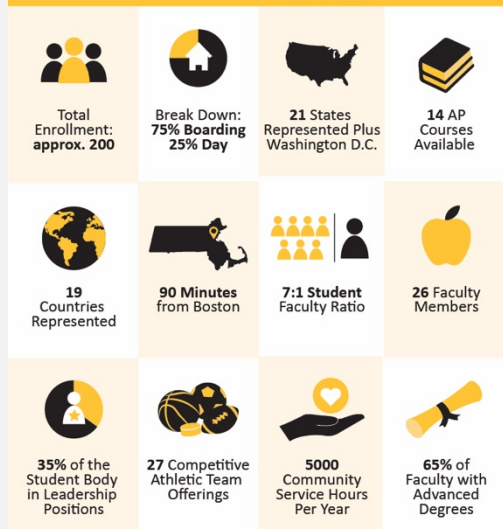

## Covid-19 Response

In accordance with the State of New Hampshire, Tilton returned to in-person learning September 2020. Three courses were offered each day; each course ran for 110 minutes Monday thru Friday. At Thanksgiving, Tilton students returned home and engaged in virtual learning until mid-January when we resumed in-person learning. Tilton School resumed a traditional school year in 2021-2022.
